You are cordially invited to join the 14th International Conference on Magnetic Resonance Microscopy (ICMRM) which will be held from August 13th to 17th, 2017 in Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada. The ICMRM conference is held under the auspices of the Spatially Resolved Magnetic Resonance Division of the Ampere Society.

The ICMRM conference will feature the first Erwin Hahn Memorial lecture to be given by Dr. Eiichi Fukushima from ABQMR in New Mexico. Dr. R. Scott Hinks, chief scientist GE Healthcare, will give the conference plenary lecture. An updated list of invited lecturers may be found on the conference web site icmrm2017.com.

The ICMRM conference is intended to showcase the most recent advances in the development and application of magnetic resonance microscopy. Recent conferences have covered spatially resolved magnetic resonance in solids, porous media, and biological tissue. The 14th conference in Halifax will continue with these topics, but will also include hardware advances, pre-clinical imaging, molecular and cellular imaging, in addition to new MR experiments.

Researchers, at all levels of experience, in the field of spatially resolved magnetic resonance are invited to present their most recent results, in the form of invited lectures, contributed oral presentations and traditional posters. There will be no parallel sessions. All posters will be on display for the duration of the conference. The conference will start with a series of educational lectures as has been past practice. A colloquium on Rheo-NMR will follow the conference on Friday the 18th of August as a satellite meeting.

Young investigators will be invited (based on submitted abstracts) to present in a special session of the conference. The Paul Callaghan Young Investigator award winner will be chosen by an expert panel from among the presentations in this special session. The winner will receive a monetary prize of \$2500 CAD. All presenters in this special session will receive free conference registration. Additional travel assistance is possible.

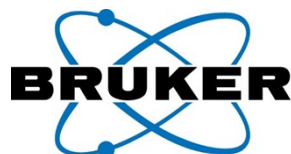
